2. Presentation by Conrad Choiniere on Closer To Zero: "FDA's Closer to Zero Initiative"

Conrad Choiniere is the Director of the Office of Analytics and Outreach at the Food and Drug Administration's (FDA) Center for Food Safety and Applied Nutrition. Dr. Choiniere provides executive leadership for a broad portfolio of scientific and regulatory functions including risk and decision analysis, social and behavioral sciences, epidemiology, biostatistics and informatics, education and outreach, and food defense. Dr. Choiniere chairs FDA's Toxic Elements Working Group which prioritizes the agency's efforts to reduce exposures to lead, arsenic and other heavy metals from foods to the greatest extent feasible.

IRAC member Agency representatives provided Agency/Codex/IFSAC/WHO updates on activities related to food safety risk assessment and research.

4. Discussion

a. Review of FY22 Accomplishments
